"Stewardship - Catch the Wave" is the theme of the 2021 Eighth National Grazing Lands Conference (8NGLC) and you are invited to participate in this highly anticipated conference being hosted by the National Grazing Lands Coalition (NatGLC) and other sponsoring organizations. The conference's purpose will serve to heighten the economic and environmental awareness of beneficial grazing lands. The target audience includes producers, academia, consumers, government agencies, conservationists, environmentalists, urban based resource interests, grazing land managers, landowners, and others interested in effective and sustainable natural resources management systems. Cooperators or partners will comprise the public sector, natural resource agencies and entities, segments of the farming and livestock industry, and environmental conservation organizations.

The conference provides an open discussion and exchange of information, technology transfer, identification of research and program needs, marketing of products, services, and other benefits of grazing. There will be opportunities for symposiums, forums, workshops, oral and poster presentations.

Paper/Stories submitted should be 400 words or less and include a description of the presentation. The paper/ stories submission deadline is May 15, 2021.
